
PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS PER COLLEGE

*GRADUATION RATES DETAIL:

Graduation rates (January 1, 2021-December 31, 2021) were calculated within 150% of normal completion time designated by the university and were completed following the method outlined by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC).

Graduation Rate Thresholds are 32% for Associate's degree programs; 43% for Bachelor's degree programs, 54% for Master's degree programs, and 40% for Doctoral program. Graduation rate goals are 56% for Associate's degree programs; 56% for Bachelor's degree programs, 63% for Master's degree programs, and 40% for Doctoral program.

150% of CSU's normal completion time for an Associate's degree is 4.5 years, a Bachelor's degree is 7.5 years, a Master's degree is 4.5 years, and a Doctoral degree is 7.5 years.

Graduation rate population includes students who are on military deployment and those currently enrolled in the indicated program.


