Credit Transfer Agreement

The Credit Transfer Agreement ("Agreement") is between Columbia Southern University ("University") with its principal place of business at 21982 University Lane, Orange Beach Alabama, 36561, and Gateway Education, LLC, and Distance Learning Systems Indiana, Inc. jointly owned and collectively operated ("Client") with its principal place of business located at 107 N State Road 135, Suite 302, Greenwood, Indiana 46142.

- 1. The Client shall submit its Client-owned professional development and training courses (general education and general elective course) for review and approval by following the University submission guidelines.
- 2. Upon submission of courses by Client, the University will evaluate the courses provided for credit transfer in accordance with University policies and procedures, and when approved will report to Client such approval on a signed Addendum "A".
- 3. This Agreement establishes the principle that all articulated Client coursework will transfer to University and that Client's students will not be required to repeat completed equivalent courses at the University.
- 4. This Agreement becomes effective on the date both parties have signed the Agreement and will continue to be in effect unless terminated in writing by either party. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Client's representative.
- 5. The parties grant, one to the other, a limited, non-exclusive right to use the other name and logo in writing including on their respective websites solely for purposes of fulfilling obligation pursuant to this Agreement.
- 6. Each party acknowledges that the relationship with the other is that of an independent contractor.
- 7. Each party agrees to abide by all applicable Federal and State Laws.
- 8. This Agreement does not create any rights, title, or interest for any entity other than the University and the Client, and only as specified herein.
- 9. Students must achieve a C or better for eligible transfer.
