- "LD" denotes lower-division credit, and "UD" denotes upper-division credit.
- A DAU transcript is required to determine credit eligibility.
- Credit will be awarded based on the ACE credit stated on the DAU transcript, CSU degree requirements at the time of enrollment, and the current CSU transfer credit policy, which are subject to change.
- Transfer credit must be in multiples of three credit hours for all CSU degree categories except undergraduate Open Electives, which may be accepted in other credit hour amounts.
- Duplicate DAU course credit will not transfer to CSU.

^{**} The DAU course may be eligible as a program elective in certain CSU degree programs.

^{***} The DAU combination of courses must be completed to be eligible for CSU credit. If the series is completed, the DAU transcript will reflect credit under one of the courses listed.

^{****} DAU graduate courses are applicable to CSU master's programs with Open Electives or General Concentration categories that do not require specific CSU courses.
