- The total transfer credit amount assumes maximum LCC general education transfer towards CSU general education requirements. The actual number of transfer credit hours awarded (and therefore the number of hours to be completed at CSU) will be based on actual courses completed successfully at LCC for which there exists a CSU equivalent and could be more or less than the number of transfer credits in the example above.

\*\* CSU's Humanities and Fine Arts-Group A requires three credit hours concentrated in Art, Literature, Religion, Music, Ethics, or Philosophy. Humanities and Fine Arts-Group B requires three credit hours in any of the aforementioned topics, Critical Thinking, Foreign Language, Speech, or select Communications courses.

\*\*\* LCC General Education Electives courses must fit the specific requirements of select CSU General Education categories to receive transfer credit. LCC General Education courses that do not satisfy CSU's General Education categories will be reviewed for Open Electives credit, if applicable.
