The Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) has completed the review of your Institution's Application for Re-Registration of Out of State Institutions pursuant to the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 (Act) based on the application received on March 30, 2020.

The application demonstrates that Columbia Southern University has met the qualifications for registration under the Act, pursuant to California Education Code (CEC) section 94801.5.

Pursuant to CEC §94801.5(d), this registration shall remain valid until April 14, 2022. Any of the following conditions will deem the institution ineligible for re-registration:

- the institution is no longer accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education;
- the institution is no longer approved to operate in their state where it maintains its main administrative location;
- failure to comply with the requirements of the Student Tuition Recovery Fund as stated in CEC section 94801.5 and regulations adopted by the Bureau.

Additionally, registered institutions shall comply with 5 CCR §76120, §76130, §76140, §76215, and §76240 regarding the collection and submission of Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) Assessments, the collection and maintenance of student information to substantiate the data reported on the STRF Assessment Reporting Form, and STRF disclosures.
